T-ball and Coach Pitch: House League Ground Rules 2018

If there are any inconsistencies between these rules and the T-ball or Coach Pitch Rules of Play, the rules on this page are to be taken as correct.

Base Coaches

- Two adult coaches may be base coaches, but there must be an adult coach in the dugout at all times.

Number of defensive players

- The maximum number of defensive players in the field is 11.
- The minimum number of players is 8.

Call-Ups

- A Call-Up is when you ask a player on another team in the age group below your division to join your team for a game.
- Call-Ups can be used if you suspect you are going to have less than 11 players at game time.
- There will be a list of players to call up to your team. If there are no players available from the list, then you may use a Call-Over.
- Coaches are responsible for finding their own Call-ups in accordance with the League's Call-up Policy.

Call-Overs

- A Call-Over is when you ask a player on another team in the same division to join your team for a game. Call-Overs are not permitted for Playoff or Championship games.

Score Books

- Score Books shall be used by both teams. Once the Playoffs begin, Score Books must be retained by each team in the event the League asks to see them. Also, the final score of all Playoff games must be reported to the League by both teams.

Fence

- If the ball bounces over or rolls under the fence, it is a ground rule double except on last batter in which case it is a ground rule triple.

Batting Order

- Teams are to bat a maximum of eleven (11) players. If a team has more than 11 players present, they must sit players both offensively and defensively.

Strikeouts

- There are no strike outs.

Game Duration

- T-ball: A House League T-ball game is 3 innings in length
- Coach Pitch: A House League Coach Pitch game is 5 innings in length
- No new inning can start after 1hr and 30min from the start of the game.
- If the game has reached 1hr and 45 min in duration, the batter at bat is permitted to complete their at bat. Once completed, the game is declared over.

Ball Type

- T-ball: A soft baseball shall be used.
- Coach Pitch: A regular baseball shall be used.
